BRYAN ROTARY PLANNING VETERANS PARADE IN DOWNTOWN BRYAN ON NOVEMBER 9th TO SHOW SUPPORT OF MILITARY VETERANS AND ACTIVE DUTY TROOPS

The Rotary Club of Bryan will give a Brazos Valley Salute to all veterans in the area with the theme, "We will never forget you." The parade will "step off" promptly at 2:30 p.m. Sunday, November 9, 2008.

The parade route: line up begins at the intersection of W 20th St and N Bryan Street, proceed south on N Bryan Street to W 28th Street, left on W 28th Street to S Main Street, then left on S Main Street, and concluding at W 20th St and N Main Street. Enter the lineup area from Martin Luther King Street onto N Bryan Street and proceed to W 20th Street for entrant parking directions. The parade in route time is about 25 minutes.
